PRODUCT HANDLING:

- It is encouraged to keep materials wrapped and weather proof until installation.
- Materials must be stored horizontally and at least 4 inches off ground.
- When unwrapping and cutting straps please be sure to not damage the Factory Finish surface.
- Wear dust mask and eye protection during installation of timber.
- Dispose of cut-offs or waste in land fill, do not burn treated or stained timber.



MAINTENANCE:

- Prior to installation wash down with water making sure the product is ready to perform.
- Wash walls every 12 months to maintain appearance.
- It is recommended to apply and additional top coat after one year of weathering.
- Depending on color saturation a re-coat is recommended every 3-4 years.

- Fasteners The use of corrosion-proof steel fastenings that conform to ASTM A153 is recommended such as 304 & 316 stainless steel.
